- A minimum of Five (5) CSEC/GCE subjects including Mathematics and English Language, with a minimum grade of 2 (CSEC) or B (GCE).
- CSEC subjects at grades 1 and 2— to pursue the corresponding CAPE subjects chosen from the options (see section on application form).

Application & Registration Process

The application for Sixth Form Pathway 1 will be done **on-line**. The application form can be accessed and completed at the following link:

Application opens on **June 16, 2023** and closes **July 14, 2023**.

Applicants will be required to pay an application & processing fee of **\$1000** at the Bursary and a copy of the receipt received must be uploaded. Hard copies of **All documents uploaded** must be taken to the school's administrative office after the application has been submitted online.

Once the applications are processed, an e-mail will be sent to each applicant confirming receipt of application, as well as information regarding the procedures for acceptance into the Pathway 1 programme.

Upon receipt of CXC results, each applicant must submit a verified copy to the school's administrative office. Once results are processed, successful applicants for Pathway 1 will be contacted by email. A package with registration documents must be collected, **completed and returned** to the Sixth Form Coordinator at registration and orientation in **September 2023**.

N.B. All applicants MUST provide a valid and appropriate e-mail address which must be checked regularly as communication will mainly take place in that format.
